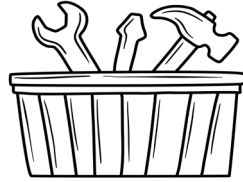


Repair Cafe Buriton



Volunteers needed

We are looking for a variety of volunteers to help with the new Repair Café that we are hoping to start in Buriton. Volunteers are just that, you only need to sign up for dates that you want to volunteer, it is not a commitment to come every month (unless you want to of course). It will run on the first Saturday of each month (10.30 to 12.30) along side the existing community Coffee morning, starting from 6th September. We are a not-for-profit organisation, but funds are needed to ensure it can be sustained so all volunteers need to be prepared to point out that donations are accepted, these being donations for repairs not the cafe, as they do their own already.

We need repairers for things like:

Garden tools; Miscellaneous items from the home; Fuse changing; Sewing repairs; Etc. If you think you have something to offer that is not on this list, please get in touch.

The idea is that Repairers only repair items

that can be repaired during the course of the Repair Café, using their own tools. If any bits are needed to facilitate the repair then the owner needs to source them and bring them back with the item. We are not looking to take work away from local businesses. We are trying to make things last longer so that they do not go into landfill unnecessarily, and that much loved items may get new life.

Meet and Greet people

Greeting people when they bring in their repairs so that they can be directed to read the relevant notices before filling in a repair form and using the cafe (if they want). Then taking their item to the log-in table to be passed to the repairers.

People to log in the repairs brought in and then return them to their owners afterwards.
