  - SDNP/25/03561/HOUS – The Hopkiln, Weston - Two storey extension to the north side of the dwelling, to provide a new entrance area and additional cloakroom and en-suite facilities.
  - SDNP/25/03900/TCA - Street Record, North Lane, Buriton - Clear the lighting column of foliage at a 60 degree angle from the head of the lamppost. Any foliage that falls in this zone, that is in line with, or in front of the column itself will need to be trimmed.
  - SDNP/25/03821/HOUS - Cobwebs , 43A North Lane, Buriton - Detached garage and store, alterations to ground levels adjacent proposed garage, Insertion of bifold doors into existing garage door opening
  - SDNP/25/03943/TCA - Quackers , High Street, Buriton - 1. Reduce Tilia by 1m and raise to 2m. Final height will be approximately 12m and 5m spread. 2. Repollard Horse Chestnut back to previous points. Final height will be approximately 12m and 6m spread. 3. Reduce Field Maple by up to 2m to suitable growth points. Final height will be approximately 10m and 6m spread. 4. Reduce Prunus by up to 2m to suitable growth points. Final height will be approximately 8m and 7m spread.
