

## From the Chairman of the Parish Council

### **Results of war memorial ballot.**

It was a high turnout of 31% which is better than most general elections!

A total of 338 packs were delivered resulting in a total distribution of 676 voting slips.

The total number of votes returned was	212
Votes For the Bench and sited behind the war memorial:	137
Votes for the Bench but sited on Pond Green:	30
Votes against the Bench	42
Votes not fitting into any category:	3 (they

were all 'for' the bench but had either a totally different location for the bench or had ticked both boxes for the 'siting' of the bench.)

Hence the following results can be determined:

79% of turnout in favour of a Bench.

65% of turnout in favour of siting it behind the War Memorial

14% of turnout in favour of siting it on Pond Green

20% of turnout against the idea of a bench

34% of turnout either didn't want a bench or preferred it sited on pond green.

### **Results of the playground consultation.**

The second matter of importance is the playground. We have reached our target and we can go ahead! That consultation resulted in 63 out of 110 voting to move it to the skate park area, away from the trees.

A big thanks from me to everyone who has worked so hard over both matters. We are so fortunate in this village to have such an active population who really care about things.

Both matters will be on the agenda for the Parish Council meeting on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> November.
